DOCUMENTS FOR CROSSING THE BORDER

To avoid encountering any problems when crossing the border, all foreign participants arriving from abroad are required to bring the following documents with them:

IF YOU NEED A VISA TO ENTER THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

You must bring the following to cross the border:

- a visa
- a valid passport
- a medical insurance policy valid on the territory of the Russian Federation (if needed)

IF YOU DO NOT NEED A VISA TO ENTER THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

You must bring the following to cross the border:

- a valid passport
- a medical insurance policy valid on the territory of the Russian Federation (if needed)



HOW TO APPLY FOR A VISA?

If you need a visa to enter the Russian Federation, you can:

- 1) **obtain a visa through an invitation for foreign arrivals** (for all Congress participants);

OR

- 2) obtain **an electronic visa** (available for citizens of 64 foreign countries).

VISA VALIDITY PERIODS

After submitting all the required documents, Congress participants can obtain a short-term, single-entry Russian visa **for the period from 15 to 30 May 2025** at foreign consular offices of the Russian Federation on the day of their application.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A VISA BY INVITATION FOR FOREIGN ARRIVALS?

An invitation for foreign arrivals is not an invitation to the Congress, but a separate document from organizers, which is available in the [Roscongress personal account](#).

1. All confirmed participants will receive an official invitation to the Congress by email.
2. After receiving the invitation, log in to your [Roscongress personal account](#) using your personal login and password.
3. Confirm your attendance at the Congress.
4. Go to the 'My events – 11th Nevsky International Ecological Congress – Event dashboard – Visa support' tab of the [Roscongress personal account](#).
5. Your personal information will be automatically uploaded from the Roscongress personal account to the document. You can manually add the city and country where you will be applying for your visa. You can contact a Roscongress Foundation specialist to make changes to the personal data. The specialist's contact information can be found in the [Roscongress personal account](#) and in your invitation letter.
6. Download and print the invitation for foreign arrivals.
7. Provide your Russian consular office with the invitation for foreign arrivals and the other required visa documents. Information about the location of Russian consular offices can be found [on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation](#).

E-VISA

Can be issued to citizens of **64** foreign countries:

Austria, Barbados, Bahrain, Belgium, Bulgaria, Bhutan, Cambodia, China, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Eswatini, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, India, Indonesia, Iran, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Jordan, Kenya, The Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Kuwait, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Monaco, Myanmar, Netherlands, North Korea, Northern Macedonia, Norway, Oman, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Saint Lucia, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkmenistan, Turkey, Vatican, Vietnam, Zimbabwe.

VISA VALIDITY PERIODS

The unified electronic visa is a single-entry visa. **The validity of the single electronic visa is 60 days** from the date of issue.

The permitted period of stay in the Russian Federation on a single electronic visa is **not more than 16 days from the day of entry** within its validity period.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR AN E-VISA?

To apply for a unified e-visa, it is necessary to fill in an application on the purpose-made [website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia](#). **The unified electronic visa is not free.** Applications may be submitted **not earlier than 40 days and no later than 4 days** before the expected date of entry into the Russian Federation.

MIGRATION REGISTRATION OF FOREIGN CITIZENS

If you are staying at a hotel, the hotel administration will automatically file a notification about the arrival of a foreign citizen with the authorities. Foreign citizens who have come to Russia for more than 7 days and **are not staying at a hotel** must register for migration purposes.

Please note that the Congress programme lasts less than 7 days. The Congress organizer is not responsible for the registration of foreign citizens for migration purposes.

TRANSIT VIA FOREIGN AIRPORTS

Should you be unable to travel directly between your point of departure and an airport in Russia, we advise flying via a country offering flights to Russia. At present, flights are available through transit points in Armenia, Egypt, India, China, Kazakhstan, the United Arab Emirates, Turkey, Serbia and Uzbekistan.

We recommend that you select the appropriate departure and arrival points, then check the website or the airport information service to see which air carriers operate regular and/or non-scheduled flights via the desired route. For more information about flights, we suggest you visit the website of your preferred air carrier. For the latest information, please visit the website of the selected airline.

TRANSFER IN MOSCOW

Should you be unable to travel directly between your point of departure and St. Petersburg, we advise flying via one of Moscow's airports.

The flight time is approximately 90 minutes. For the latest information, please visit the websites of [Sheremetyevo](#), [Domodedovo](#), and [Vnukovo](#) airports and your airlines of interest. Alternatively, you may contact airlines directly.

If you plan to fly to Moscow and take an onward journey to St. Petersburg by train, the convenient Aeroexpress trains allow you to travel via the following routes in comfort. Please visit the '[Aeroexpress](#)' website to view timetables and purchase tickets.

BY RAIL

St. Petersburg has five rail terminals: Moskovsky, Ladozhsky, Vitebsky, Finlyandsky, and Baltiysky. Each of St. Petersburg's rail terminals is conveniently situated and serves suburban and international routes.

MOSCOW – ST. PETERSBURG

Sapsan high-speed trains depart from Leningradsky Terminal in Moscow, and arrive at Moskovsky Rail Terminal in St. Petersburg. The journey time ranging from 3.5 to 4 hours. Please visit the [Russian Railways website](#) for a detailed Sapsan timetable.

ACCESS TO THE VENUE



Upon arrival, each participant will have to go through the access control procedure. The participant may be asked to turn on your phone or laptop and show other equipment that you brought to the venue.

In order to avoid any inconvenience when accessing the venue, participants are advised to leave any items prohibited at the Congress venue at their accommodation or in their vehicle. Please carefully review the [list of items prohibited on the event venue](#) and pay attention to any exceptions.



BADGE COLLECTION

An accreditation badge is a pass to the 11th Nevsky International Ecological Congress venue. We do recommend **receiving your badge in advance**.

You must carry your badge and identity document (passport) with you at all times when at the Congress venue.

The badge is personalized and may not be transferred to third parties.

If your badge is lost or damaged, you should contact any accreditation desk or Help Desk.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO PICK UP MY BADGE?

In the 'My events – 11th Nevsky International Ecological Congress – Event dashboard' section of the [Roscongress personal account](#) you should:

1. Confirm participation in the Congress

2. Enter your personal information in full

in accordance with your passport

3. Upload a required photo for your badge:

- Colour photo against a light background;
- Photo size – 480 × 640 pixels;
- Photo format – JPG or JPEG;
- Full-face photo with no headgear;
- Your face must take up at least 70% of the photo.

4. Upload a scanned copy of your passport (pages 2 and 3)

Please make sure that the scanned copy is legible and contains complete information about the data you gave when registering, including the series and number of the document, the issue date, the issuing authority, and a photo. Formats: jpg, jpeg, pdf, png.

Data processing takes from 3 days.

If changes have been made to your identity document (passport) after you completed the application to participate in the Congress, the data in your [Roscongress personal account](#) must be edited (tab 'My events – 11th Nevsky International Ecological Congress – Event dashboard – Personal information – Edit data').

To make changes to any fields that are blocked for editing, please contact the specialist that you spoke with when registering for the Congress.



When issuing the badge, the accreditation operator checks the data specified in the [Roscongress personal account](#) to ensure it matches the information in your identity document. If the data does not match, the badge cannot be issued on the day you applied for it.

Please check your personal data in the Roscongress personal account before obtaining the badge.

To pick up a badge for another participant by proxy, the authorized individual must present:

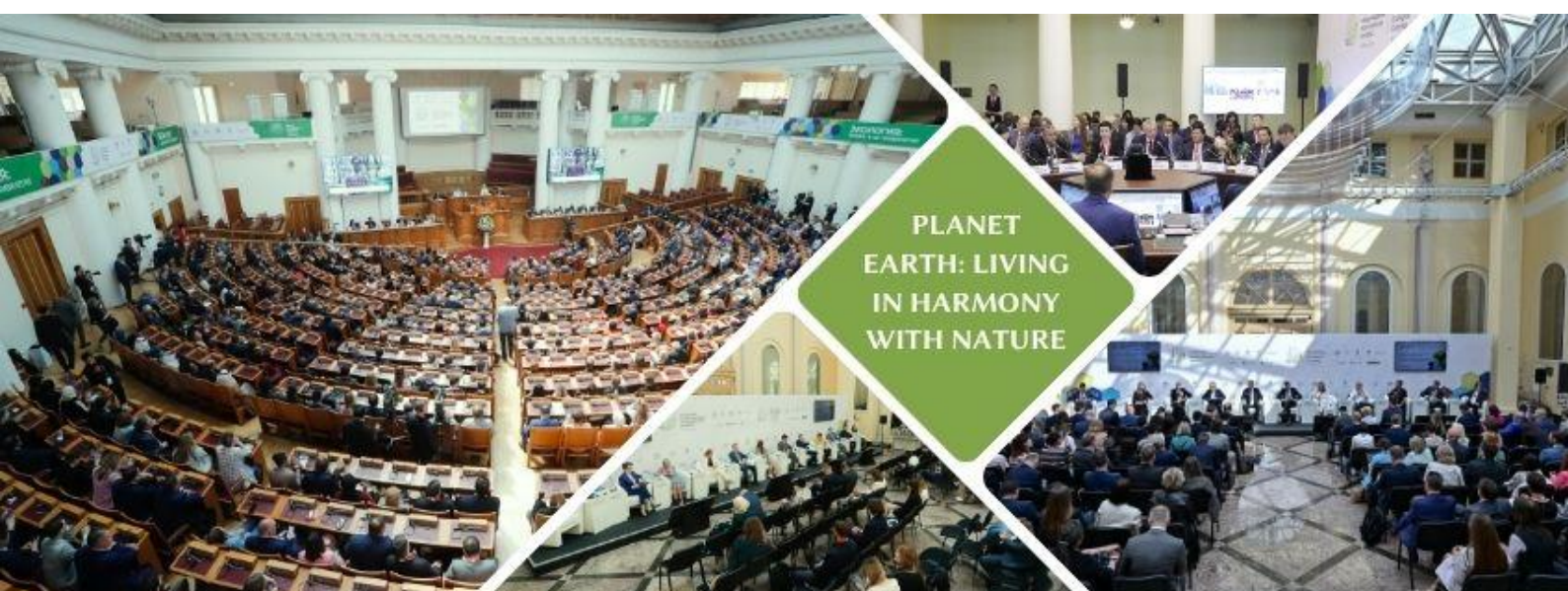

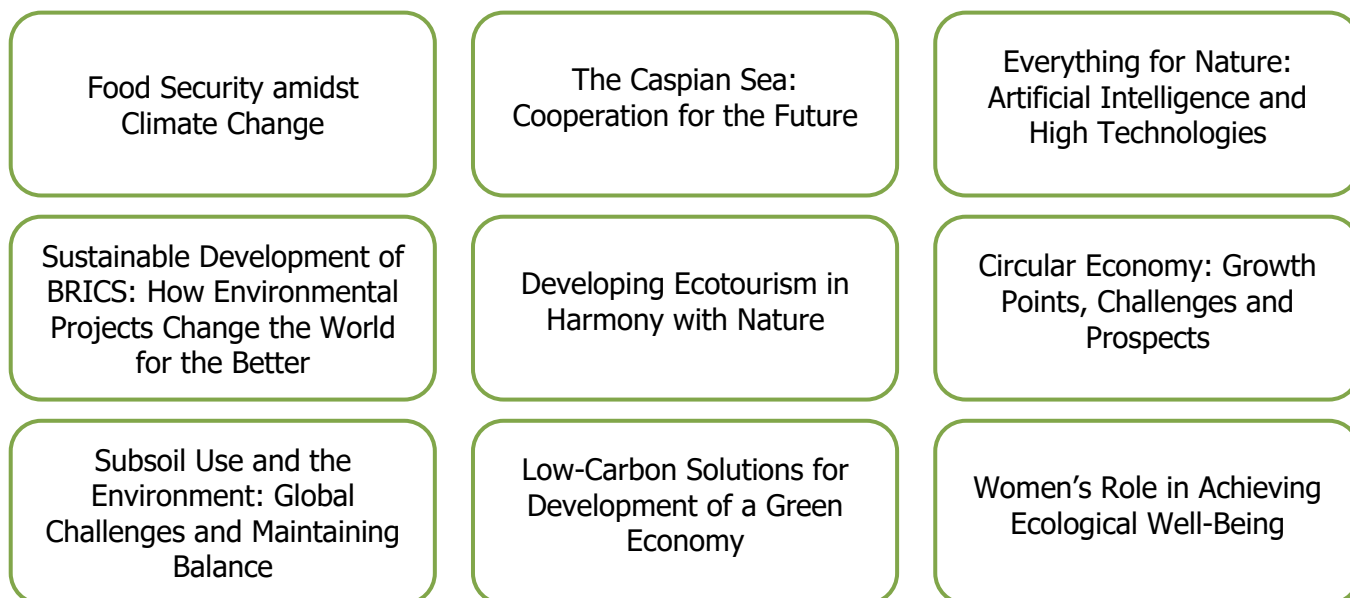

BUSINESS PROGRAMME

The key theme of the 11th Nevsky International Ecological Congress is '**Planet Earth: Living in Harmony with Nature**'. The event will cover a broad range of issues:



One of the most important Congress tracks will tackle the **development of the circular economy** and will include discussions on state policy for the development of a circular economy in Russia, the 'Ecological Wellbeing' national project as a new stage in the development of the solid waste industry, legislative regulation of the industry, new infrastructure, and state support for green projects. **The international discussion platform 'The Ecology of Large Cities'** will draw examples from real cities as it hosts a discussion of the outlook for well-being.

Domestic and foreign companies will share their experience with biotechnologies, robotics, information systems, and artificial intelligence, share technological innovations, and discuss personnel training at the session '**Everything for Nature: Artificial Intelligence and High Technologies**'.

The discussion during the session '**BRICS Sustainable Development: How Environmental Projects Change the World for the Better**' will center around multilateral and bilateral projects carried out within the BRICS environmental track. Interstate cooperation will also be on the agenda as the federal and regional authorities of Russia and the states surrounding the Caspian discuss the Caspian ecosystem, as well as during other events of the 11th Nevsky International Ecological Congress.

Topics on the agenda for the Meeting of the State Council Commission on **Environmental Welfare** will include the measures needed to achieve the national goal, the socio-economic development of the regions, and the implementation of the Federal Scientific and Technical Programme as it relates to environmental development among others.

The Congress interstate events will also include a discussion of the outlook for cooperation between Russia and Central Asia in water and energy, and representatives of the executive authorities and Russian and foreign protected areas will join UNESCO experts in a discussion of the management of transboundary World Heritage sites.

The highlight of the business programme of the 11th Nevsky International Ecological Congress will be the **plenary session 'Ecology of the New Reality: Challenges and Opportunities'**,

which will be moderated by the Speaker of the Federation Council and the Council of the Interparliamentary Assembly of the Member Nations of the Commonwealth of Independent States Valentina Matviyenko.

An eventful youth programme packed full of important environmental activities has been timed to coincide with the 11th Nevsky International Ecological Congress in St. Petersburg. The youth agenda consists of round tables on environmental education and culture, eco-volunteering, a meeting of climate initiative youth leaders from different countries, and an EcoGTO environmental relay race among other events.

The eco-mobile is a vehicle that collects a wide range of hazardous waste (12 types) from the population of St. Petersburg.

The eco-mobile is equipped with containers for separate waste collection, including special galvanized containers for mercury-containing lamps, scales, protective glasses for environmental specialists, a respirator, gloves, and a demercurization kit.

'We're for Cleanliness' city clean-up day

This massive event will be a logical continuation of the nationwide 'We're for Cleanliness' week of clean-up days, which took place on 18–27 April 2025 and brought together hundreds of thousands of people in 89 regions of Russia with nine key focuses ranging from preserving historical heritage to improving urban and protected areas.

The clean-up campaign is part of the 'History' focus, since volunteers will be cleaning up the area around the monument to the Young Heroes of the Defence of the City of Lenin with the involvement of special military operation participants and their families, activists from patriotic and environmental organizations, as well as honoured guests of the Congress.

In addition, as part of the clean-up day, the EcoGTO environmental relay race will be held in an effort to promote knowledge about ecology and instil a responsible attitude towards natural resources.

BUSINESS PARTNERSHIP PLATFORM

CURRENCY AND BANK CARD TRANSACTIONS

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

The official currency in Russia is the Russian ruble with banknotes in denominations of 10, 50, 100, 200, 500, 1,000, 2,000, and 5,000 roubles. Current information on exchange rates can be obtained on the website of the Central Bank of Russia: cbr.ru.

Please note the following currency exchange restrictions in the Russian Federation:

- It is not possible to withdraw roubles/foreign currency at an ATM or receive cash at a point of sale using Mastercard or Visa cards issued outside of Russia. These cards can also not be used for the payment of goods and services in Russia.
- Only cash in US dollars or euros can be freely exchanged for cash in roubles in most banks in Russia. Some bank offices can exchange Chinese yuan, United Arab Emirates dirham, Turkish lira and cash in other currencies.
- For currency exchange operations you must present an identity document. If the exchange exceeds the equivalent of USD 10,000, it must be declared in writing.

BANK CARDS

Given the existing restrictions on the use of foreign bank cards in Russia, we recommend that you carry cash with you for the entire duration. Mir and UnionPay cards in any currency work without restrictions in Russia.

Congress participants are advised, where possible, to apply for a card or bring an existing card from either of these payment systems.

Please note the UnionPay cards are not accepted at all retail outlets. Additionally, failures may occur when using these cards, and transactions may not go through.



WEATHER IN ST. PETERSBURG

St. Petersburg has a humid coastal climate. Average air temperature at the end of May is +16...+18 °C.

Due to the city's geographic position and its proximity to the Baltic Sea an extreme change of weather is possible. We recommend Congress guests to bring warm clothing and an umbrella with them.

DRAWBRIDGE SCHEDULE

A slew of drawbridges is an integral part of the main waterways of St. Petersburg. Therefore, when moving around the city center at night, you should take into account the actions of sea and river navigation and check your route with the schedule of the bridges.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The Congress venue is furnished with modern safety equipment, including video surveillance and fire extinguishing systems.

In case of evacuation announcement, participants should:

- Keep calm and follow instructions of the Congress staff, the police and other persons responsible for maintaining public order and fire safety as well as the voice alarm instructions.
- Not interfere with rescue personnel, police and transport operations.
- Leave the venue according to the evacuation plans and follow the exit signs.
- Give way to vehicles with sound and light signalling devices.
